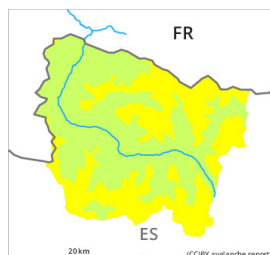


Danger Level 2 - Moderate



Tendency: Decreasing avalanche danger
on Monday 29 04 2024



Wind slab



Snowpack stability: **poor**

Frequency: **some**

Avalanche size: **medium**

Wind slabs at the southern and western borders of Aran.

As a consequence of new snow and a strong southerly wind, precarious wind slabs will form in the course of the day in particular in the regions of the south exposed to the foehn wind. Valleys of Molières and Conangles and circuses of Saboredó, Colomèrs and Valarties: The wind slabs can be released by a single winter sport participant in some cases in particular on very steep shady slopes above approximately 2100 m. Sometimes the avalanches in these locations are medium-sized.

Other regions, Below approximately 2500 m the avalanche situation is more favourable.

Snowpack

In the south 20 to 30 cm of snow has fallen since Friday above approximately 2100 m. The strong wind has transported the new snow significantly. This snow is lying on top of a quite favourable old snowpack on shady slopes.

Tendency

Monday: The avalanche danger will not decrease for the time being.
